

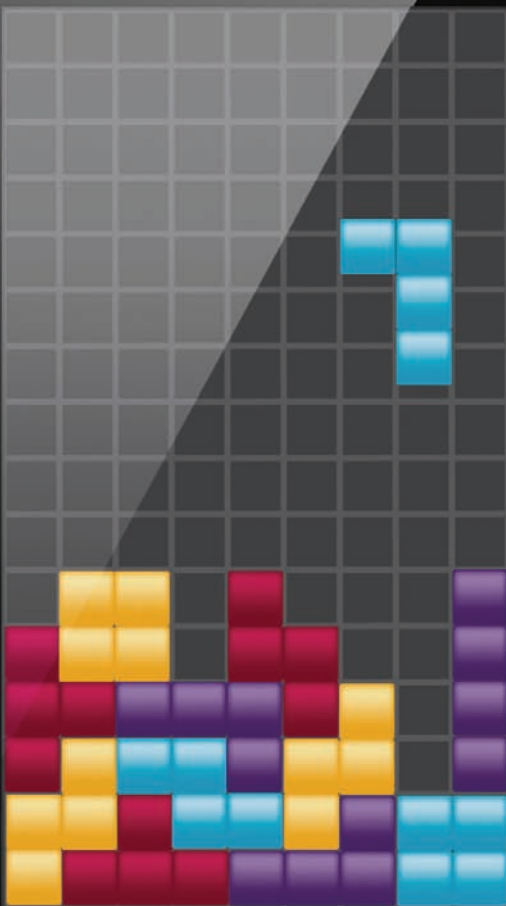

Strand Groups + Workshops + Bible Talks

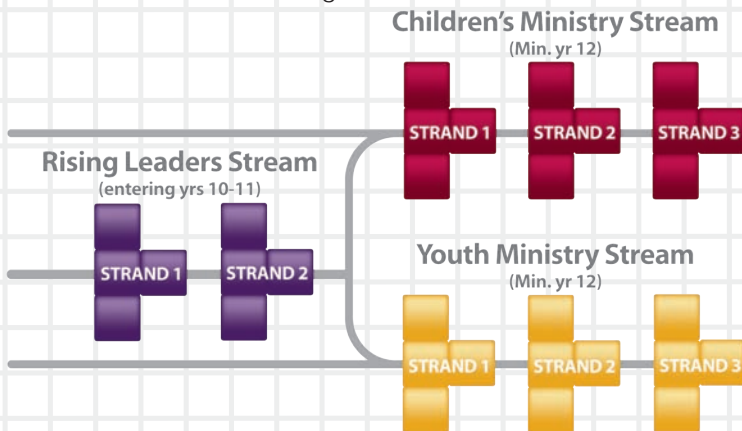

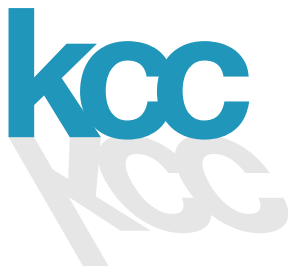
DATES
